



THE HERBERT PROTOCOL

Do you live with or know someone who has Dementia?



Dementia is caused by changes in the brain



Sometimes people with dementia forget where they live. They can get lost.



When people do get lost, the Police want to help find them quickly.



We can all use The Herbert Protocol to help Police find missing people with dementia.



The Herbert Protocol is a form.

The form tells the Police all about the person with dementia



The form can be used for people with dementia who:


Live in a care home, or

Live in their own home, or


Live with family



Someone who cares for the person with dementia can fill in the form



The form asks questions about the person. Things like..



What the person looks like



Favourite places where the person likes to go



If they take any medication



A photograph



If the person goes missing this information will help Police to find them.



The Herbert Protocol form helps Police find people with Dementia who go missing
